



**APPROVED EARNED TIME PROGRAMS  
October 14, 2016**

Utah Code 77-27-5.4 requires the Board of Pardons and Parole (Board) and the Utah Department of Corrections (Corrections) to establish an Earned Time Program that reduces the period of incarceration for offenders who successfully complete programs designed to reduce recidivism. These programs must be approved by the Board in collaboration with Corrections. In addition to successfully completing an approved program, the offender must meet the other criteria specified in statute to be eligible for an early release.

The following is a list of programs approved for credit in the Earned Time Program. Approved programs must maintain high fidelity and performance standards or they are subject to removal from the approved list. This list supersedes all previous lists. The effective date refers to the date the program was approved. Individuals who *successfully complete the program on or after the effective date are eligible* for Earned Time credit, assuming the other conditions of the statute have been met.
