

STATEWIDE ONLY WARRANTS

(NON-NCIC – DO NOT EXTRADITE)

1. From time to time, (for example: misdemeanor arrests in other states, persons paroled to ICE detainers, persons serving prison sentences in other jurisdictions) a Board Member may issue a Board Warrant as “**Statewide**” or “**Statewide Only**.”
2. A **Statewide Only** warrant means, and is meant to convey to anyone and everyone, including AP&P, DOC, CCJJ, other law enforcement and corrections personnel in other jurisdictions, and Board staff, that the Board is willing to issue a warrant to re-take the offender and return him/her to prison, but only if the offender is arrested on the warrant within the state of Utah.
3. A **Statewide Only** warrant means that the Board **does not** want the warrant listed on NCIC; **does NOT** want the offender extradited from any other state or federal custody, and **does NOT** want the warrant lodged as a detainer if the offender is in custody in another jurisdiction.
4. When the Board Member reviews and issues the warrant designating the warrant as “**Statewide**” or “**Statewide Only**”, Board staff will clear or void any active Board warrant and issue a new warrant with the same process as any other warrant, with the following additional steps:
 - a. First, when issuing a **Statewide Warrant**, in O-Track on the Warrant Detail screen, the words “**Statewide Only**” are to be typed into the Description space, as noted below:

Accept Allegation

- By having failed to immediately report to Adult Probation and Parole upon release from custody, in violation of a standard condition of the Parole Agreement.
- By having failed to report as directed on or about 10/26/2011 in violation of a standard condition of the Parole Agreement.
- By having absconded from parole supervision, on or about 10/26/2011, in violation of a standard condition of the Parole Agreement.
- By having failed to pay restitution in violation of a special condition of the Parole Agreement.
- By having failed to complete Substance Abuse Therapy, on or about 10/26/2011, in violation of a special condition of the Probation/Parole Agreement.

- b. An e-mail is to be sent to the AP&P Agent requesting the warrant, as well as his/her supervisor, informing them that the Warrant has been issued as “**Statewide Only – Do NOT Extradite, Do NOT List on NCIC**”. This e-mail **must also** be sent to the following AP&P employees:
